**A**nna (Davi) Teobaldo, 85, of Punta Gorda, FL passed away on July 22, 2025. Anna was born January 14, 1940, to Pietro and Pietrina Davi in Camporeale, a town in the province of Palermo, Sicily, Italy.

Anna and Salvatore eventually left behind snowy winters to settle in the sunny warmth of Southwest Florida. Anna was an incredible cook whose talents brought people together. Her homemade sauce, pasta, cream puffs, cannoli, and countless varieties of Italian cookies graced family celebrations, weddings, and holidays. She delighted in preparing cookie trays for special occasions and continued canning tomatoes and olives well into her later years, always sharing her creations with love. She taught her granddaughter and friends how to make her specialties from scratch, passing down her traditions with joy and generosity.

She adored spending time with her grandchildren and great-granddaughters, making memories that will be treasured forever. She and Salvatore made many trips back to Italy to visit their beloved family there.
