John Joseph "Vince" Vinciguerra, age 94, passed away peacefully on December 11, 2025, in Fort Myers, Florida.

Born on May 18, 1931, in New York, New York, Vince was the beloved son of the late Liberato and Anna Vinciguerra. He grew up in New York and was a proud graduate of Brooklyn Technical High School. He went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering from Bradley University, where he also played football.

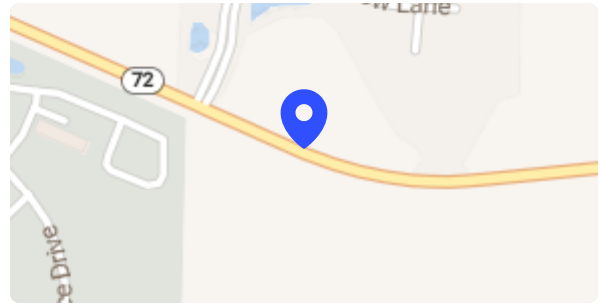

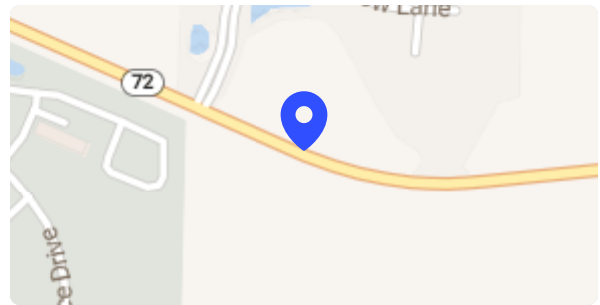
