**L**eonard J. Hill, Jr., 83, of Fort Myers, Florida, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 20, 2025, at Health Park Hospital.

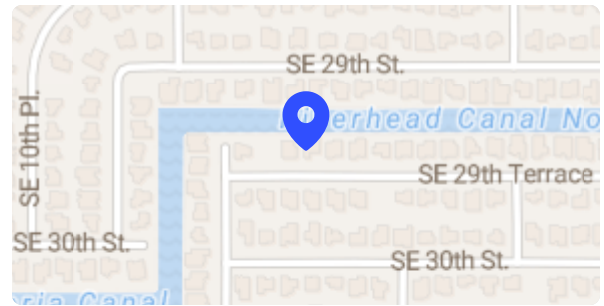

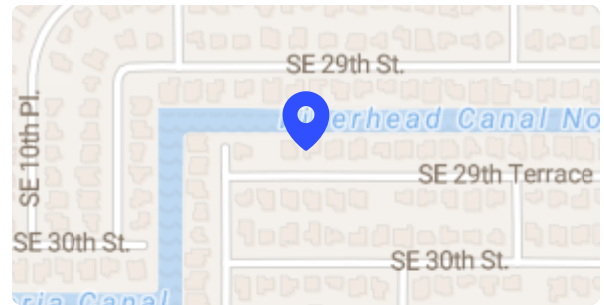

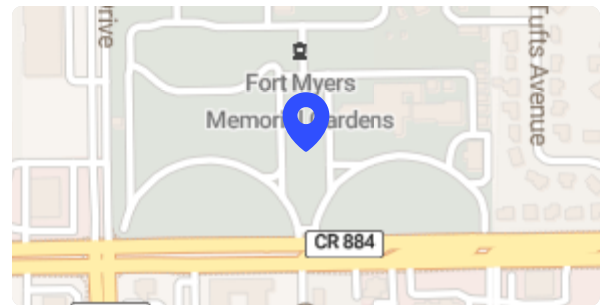
